POST TOUR - KWAZULU NATAL **08 – 11 APRIL 2017**

- **Tour starts at 1200 on Saturday 08 April 2017 from King Shaka Airport Durban.**

DAY 1: CAPE TOWN - SHAKALAND

08 APRIL 2017

Transfer from Cape Sun Hotel to Cape Town Airport for your flight to Durban. Upon arrival meet and greet and travel to Shakaland, which is situated 160km north of the city of Durban. It is a living monument to Zulu Culture, enjoy afternoon cultural program and dinner will be served in the Shisa Nyama restaurant with its authentic setting and traditional Zulu style and ethnic dishes.

Overnight: Shakaland (Lunch, Dinner)

DAY 2: SHAKALAND – HLUHLUWE IMFOLOZI PARK

09 April 2017

Departure after breakfast for Hluhluwe – Imfolozi Park, is the oldest proclaimed nature reserve in Africa. It consist of 96 000 ha of hilly topography. Due to conservation efforts, the park now has the largest population of white rhino's in the world. Then park also boast with the "Big Five" animals such as lion, leopard, elephant, buffalo and rhino can be seen. Lunch stop on route. Afternoon game drive in open vehicles.

Overnight: Hilltop (Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner)

DAY 3: HLUHLUWE IMFOLOZI PARK – MKHUZE – ERMELO

10 April 2017

Early morning game drive followed by breakfast and then travel to Mkhuze for a visit to Senekal Boerdery, South Africa's largest sugarcane farm, has 35000ha under irrigation, and adds an extra 600ha annually. Charl Senekal heads the business, joined by his three sons and three senior managers.

Overnight: Guesthouse in Ermelo (Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner)

DAY 4: ERMELO – JOHANNESBURG

11 April 2017

Depart for the Buffalo Valley, farm of John Roos who breed indigenous Drakensberg Cattle Buffalo Valley came into being when John and a partner, both born and bred townsmen, entered farming with the purchase of a Highveld farm, with the aim of producing milk from the veld. (A decade or two, three, ago this was common practice throughout the country). Dairy breeds were used, but it was found that the cows yielding the greatest volume of milk under Highveld conditions were black cows, or so-called Veld Friesians, later identified by the pundits as Drakensbergers. These black cows formed the nucleus of the Buffalo Valley's Drakensberger stud of today. Lunch on the farm with the Roos family. Arrive late afternoon in Johannesburg. Drop off can be either at OR Tambo Airport or hotel of your choice near the OR Tambo Airport. **End of tour.**
