## POST TOUR - NAMIBIA 08 – 12 APRIL 2017

- Tour starts at 1200 on Saturday 08 April 2017 from Eros Airport Windhoek.
- Transfer from the Cape Sun Hotel is included in the price.
- We suggest you book flight CPT – WDH SA8122 0830 - 1035.
- Tour will end on Tuesday 11 April 2017 at Eros Airport Windhoek Namibia at 1500.

### **DAY 1: CAPE TOWN - OTJIWARONGO**

**08 APRIL 2017**

Transfer from Cape Sun Hotel to Cape Town Airport for your flight to Windhoek. Upon arrival meet and greet and travel to the Cheetah Conservations Fund, founded in Namibia in 1990 by Dr Laurie Marker and executive Director of CCF. Having worked with Cheetahs since 1974, Laurie set up a not for profit fund in 1990 and moved to Namibia to develop a permanent Conservation Research Centre for the wild cheetah. Afternoon tour of the centre.

**Overnight: Aloe Grove Safari Lodge (Lunch, Dinner )**

### **DAY 2: OTJIWARONGO – GROOTFONTEIN**

**09 April 2017**

Early morning Cheetah run and then departure for Grootfontein. Visit the farm of Mecki Schneider, / Okabra Brahman Stud.

The Okabra Brahman Stud, from the northern part of Namibia, has established itself since its inception in 1987 as one of the leading and one of the largest Brahman studs in Southern Africa. The Schneider family has been in extensive cattle ranching as its core business since 1913 at Okamutombe near Grootfontein and thus bring along a successful history of sustainable beef production.

**Overnight: Peace Garden Lodge ( Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner)**

### **DAY 3: GROOTFONTEIN – ETOSHA NATIONAL PARK**

**10 April 2017**

Depart for Etosha National Park which is unique in Africa. The park's main characteristic is a salt pan so large it can be seen from space. Yet there is abundant wildlife that congregates around the waterholes, giving you almost guaranteed game sightings. Evening game drive in open vehicles. Halali is situated between a few hills and koppies, the thicker vegetation make this popular with leopard, rhino and elephant.

**Overnight: Halali Camp ( Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner)**

### **DAY 4: ETOSHA NATIONAL PARK**

**11 April 2017**

Full day travel in Etosha National Park. The day starts with an early morning game drive. Travel west to the camp of Okaukuejo. Evening game drive in open vehicles.

**Overnight: Okaukuejo Camp( Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner)**

**DAY 5: ETOSHA NATIONAL PARK – WINDHOEK.**

**12 April 2017**

Early morning game drive in open vehicle and then departure for Windhoek. Arrive at 1500 in time for connecting flights to Johannesburg. End of tour ( Breakfast, Lunch )
