DAY 1: CAPE TOWN – LIVINGSTON ZAMBIA

08 April 2017

Transfer from the Cape Sun Hotel the Cape Town Airport for your flight to Livingston. Arrive in Livingstone and transferred to Camp Nkwazi Lodge. A small private tented lodge that has 10 rooms on the banks of the Zambezi River. Lunch upon arrival

Evening sundowner cruise on the Zambezi River

Overnight Camp Nkwazi (Lunch, Dinner)

DAY 2: LIVINGSTON

09 April 2017

Morning visit to an ex Zimbabwean farmer who has developed the farm from a “Green fields project” Tobacco, bananas, wheat and ground nuts.

Lunch at the Elephant Café 4. A newly built exclusive tented restaurant on the banks of the Zambezi River. Enjoy a 5 star lunch whilst interacting with elephant.

Afternoon visit a tilapia fish farm on the banks of the Zambezi River.

DAY 3: LIVINGSTON - LUSAKA

10 April 2017

After breakfast tour of the Victoria Falls (Zambian side)

Midday fly to Lusaka. Met upon arrival and visit ACG Farming operation and head quarters just outside Lusaka. Lunch at the farm. Late afternoon drive to Chisamba Safari Lodge. Situated in a private game reserve an hour and half’s drive out of Lusaka.

DAY 4: LUSAKA

11 April 2017

0800 After breakfast, you will depart the lodge to visit Zambeef Chisamba Farms. One of the largest commercial farming operations in Zambia and listed on the stock exchange. The group is principally involved in the production, processing, distribution and retailing of beef, chicken, pork, milk, dairy products, eggs, stock feed, flour and bread. The group also has large row cropping operations (principally maize, soya beans and wheat). They grow 8000 ha of row crops under irrigation and 9000 ha of rain-fed/dry-land crops. 900 head of cattle are milked. Their ethos is

to produce from Field to Floor and have over 87 retail outlets throughout Zambia. They have now invested in Nigeria and Ghana. Today you will visit their dairy farm & feed lot
Lunch with farmer and afternoon visit a commercial farmer – arable, beef, game farm and tobacco.

Overnight Chisamba Safari Lodge (Breakfast, Dinner)

DAY 5: LUSUAKA – HOME

Transfer to the Lusaka Airport - will be at the airport at 1100. **End of tour.**
